



Frequently Asked Questions about Serving

Mission Kids is a great place to meet other families and get involved in the lives of children ages 4-5th grades. Our focus at Mission Kids is:

- to know and love Jesus
- to go and tell others

We use *The Jesus Storybook Bible* to teach children that God's Word is all about ONE Person, the Lord Jesus Christ, and how knowing Jesus changes everything—the way we relate to God and to the world around us.

What do Mission Kids workers do?

How often would I serve at Mission Kids?

Mission Kids team members serve on two rotating teams, 3 weeks on/3 weeks off, September-July. This allows each team to finish one complete Bible & Missions unit at a time with the children.

How old do workers need to be to serve at Mission Kids?

We ask that team members be at least in 6th grade. Pre-teen, teens and adults welcome!

CAN'T MAKE A COMMITMENT TO SERVE ON SUNDAY EVENINGS? Consider these other Children's Ministry opportunities:

- ☆ Kids QUEST (Sunday mornings at one service, each week)
- ☆ Nursery Team (once/5 weeks)
- ☆ GEO Kidz Small Group Leader (midweek, 2x/month)
- ☆ Helper in Children's Music Ministry (Sunday mornings, 9-9:30)
- ☆ PNO Caregiver (respite care for families with children with special needs, 1x/month)
